There are no foreseeable risks to participation in this study. You are aware that your participation in this survey is completely voluntary. As such, if you are uncomfortable answering any of the questions, you may exit the survey. Your decision not to participate will not affect you in any way, and will not affect any services provided to you by Rutgers.

Potential benefits of participating in this survey include automatic entry into a raffle where the winner gets a \$150 Amazon gift card when the survey closes and is informed by email. You may get renewed focus from being reminded of the reasons why you chose to be in your line of work. You may also benefit indirectly in future from the findings of this research. However, it is possible that you may receive no direct benefit from taking part in this study.
